Oklahoma D-Day Insurance Rules for Tanks:

A. Basic Requirements:

1. Tanks must have 360 degree visibility for the driver. There must be safety netting for the window areas so visibility can be clear at all times. NO GLASS WINDOWS ALLOWED. All exposed glass MUST be removed OR completely covered with approved paintball netting and windshield wipers MUST be operational.
2. Tank MUST be mechanically able to get around the field. Brakes MUST work for all tanks.
3. Tank MUST have the new target system on all four sides of it's chassis.
4. Tanks must furnish their own 2' x 3' white flag to signal that they have been eliminated.
5. Tanks must furnish their own 2' x 3' yellow flag to signal that they are disabled.
6. Tanks MUST furnish their own fire extinguisher.
7. Tank crew MUST have a watch or timepiece of some kind with them on the tank while in play.
8. Tanks MUST show their team color by flying a 2' x 3' flag—Red for German, Blue for Allied.
9. Tanks MUST provide their own hole punch for punching "Kill Cards."
10. Tanks MUST furnish their own standard office clipboard, to be kept WITH the vehicle.
11. IMPORTANT NOTICE: A "Kill Card" will be issued for each tank by the Game Coordinator when it's crew takes the required Tank Course. It will be the responsibility of the Tank Commander to keep track of this card at all times once it has been issued to him.
12. Markers may use ANY mode of shooting, semi-auto, or burst, full auto modes.
13. Tanks MUST designate one MAIN gun/AT gun with a ribbon of Flagging tape if they wish to shoot anti-tank paint to eliminate other tanks and designated structures.

B. Mortars:

ONLY approved Scepter Combat Systems Mortars may be shot out of tanks. Mortars are only allowed to be used at a 45 degree angle or greater against infantry, firing standard Scepter paint grenades/mortar rounds. NO PAINTBALL MULTI-ROUND LOADS WILL BE ALLOWED IN PLAY, whether from a homemade or commercially manufactured cannon. No loads firing multiple paintballs will be allowed of any kind. (initials) _____

C. Rockets:

Rockets, Nerf rockets or similar devices may NOT be used against tanks or in game play. (initials) _____

D. Bazooka and Cannons:

No barrel diameter restrictions if shooting paintball gun inserts (marker-in-a-tube), pump or semi-auto. NO PAINTBALL MULTI-ROUND LOADS WILL BE ALLOWED IN PLAY, whether fired from a homemade or commercially manufactured cannon. No loads firing multiple paintballs will be allowed of any kind. Only Scepter Combat Systems Launchers/Mortars firing standard Scepter paint grenades/mortar rounds will be allowed as mortars/grenade launchers fired from tanks.
